

Modesto High School – Site Specific Dress Code

PROHIBITED APPAREL

(Approved by the School Safety Committee 1/31/2019)

1. No solid red or blue items including, but not limited to, scrunchies, belts, shoelaces, beanies, or rosaries.
2. No predominately red or blue shirts or sweatshirts.
3. No red or blue items hanging over the shoulder or hanging out of the pockets.
4. No red or blue apparel exposed under any shirt or collar.
5. No apparel that represents gang life including gang numbers, symbols, and/or letters.
6. No apparel containing profanity and/or images and slogans promoting drugs, alcohol, tobacco, and other themes deemed inappropriate.
7. No gang related belts or belt buckles with initials carved out.
8. No bandanas or shirts with bandana print.
9. No “Cortez” shoes and/or “Cortez” insignia on shoes.
10. No gang related or Profane Tattoos. They must be covered.
11. No gang related haircuts such as “mud flap”, Mongolian, or any other style deemed to be gang related.
12. No baseball caps, hats, beanies, visors, or other head coverings.
13. No notches shaved in/on eyebrows.
14. No excessively short shorts, skirts, and dresses.
15. No back-less clothing, tube tops/dresses, and/or bare midriffs.
16. No “Cookies” logo on apparel, backpacks, or any other items.
17. No California clothing or articles with the “NIA” in red.

These are some, but not all, dress items not allowed to be worn on Modesto High Campus per the school dress code.
